Work on processing through that while also working almost non-stop for ten days (with a waking infant overnight) and you have our hectic trip to HCJB Global's Ministry Service Center. While our trip was busy and tiring, it was also quite productive. We got the tools we needed to build up a long-term support team, what we will experience as we transition to the field and begin service, and information about how things are done at HCJB Global. The last evening of our trip we had a potluck with several of the HCJB

Global families and gave a fake support-raising presentation with our fellow appointee, Morgan, who we met in April when we interviewed at HCJB Global. We had a fun evening and enjoyed ending our time on a light note. We are taking a much-needed break from traveling and spending all of July in Murfreesboro to get together everything we need for raising support and to begin building our long-term support team.

Currently we have about 5% of our outgoing expenses in and 3% of our monthly support pledged. Over the coming weeks and months we will be making lots of calls and presentations to individuals and groups to discuss our ministry with HCJB Global to ask people to join our team. We would love to have you be a part of our ministry with HCJB Global.

## Radio Station Planting in Nepal

Approximately 93% of Nepal's population is considered unreached, which means they do not have any access to the Gospel. Nepal has long been considered a country closed to Christianity. In May two members of HCJB Global's Asia-Pacific team (where we will be working) were able to go into Nepal and set up two FM radio stations in order to spread the Gospel in Nepal. The stations have a 25 to 50 mile radius and will be run by a partner ministry in Nepal. God opened an incredible door with these stations and it will be exciting to see how He uses them to take His name to the Nepalese.
